Service every
10,000 miles
or **1 year**,
whichever comes first.



Complimentary factory scheduled maintenance covers the first three (3) regularly scheduled maintenance services at 10,000 miles or one year (whichever comes first); 20,000 miles or two years (whichever comes first); and 30,000 miles or three years (whichever comes first).

Every **10,000 miles** or **1 year**, whichever comes first

- Engine Oil and Filter: Replace**
- Service Reminder Indicator (SRI): Reset**
Clears codes for next scheduled service.
- Engine Coolant: Check/Adjust Antifreeze Rating and Anti-Corrosion Agent**
- Automatic Transmission Control: Check Park/Neutral Position (PNP) Switch**
- Washer Fluid: Check/Adjust**
- Check all wiper blades and washer systems for both windshields and headlights for functionality and signs of wear.**
- External Lighting: Check**
- Horn: Check Function**
- Seatbelts: Check Function**
- Brake Fluid Level: Check/Adjust**
- Brake Fluid: Replace Every 3 Years**
Volvo recommends to replace every 3 years (if driven in mountainous areas or humid climates—every year) at owner's expense.
- Brake Pads/Disks: Check**
- Wheels and Tires: Check Wear and Condition**
- Spare Tire Check for Damage, Wear, and Tire Pressure**
Check spare tire pressure (where applicable) every 2 years or every 40,000 miles.

Every **20,000** Miles (20, 40, 60, 80, 100, 120, 140)

- **Perform all items listed under “Every 10,000 Miles” section and include the items listed below.**
- **Engine/Transmission/Timing Gear: Check for Leaks**
In the event of a leak from the transmission, check the oil level.
- **Automatic Transmission Fluid Level: Check for Leaks/Adjust**
- **Headlights, Fog Lights: Check and Align**
- **Cabin Air Filter: Replace**
Volvo recommends that the filter be replaced at least once a year or more often in heavy traffic and dirty/dusty areas.
- **Wheels and Tires: Check Inflation Pressure**
- **Reset Tire Pressure Monitor System**
- **Cleaning inside windshield in front of camera for cars with Collision Warning.**
Clean at first 20,000 miles only.

Every **40,000** Miles (40, 80, 120)

- **Perform all items listed under “Every 20,000 Miles” section and include the items listed below.**
- **Fuel Lines and Fuel Filter: Check for Leakage And Damage**
- **Engine Air Cleaner (ACL): Clean the Air Cleaner Housing/Replace Filter**
May be necessary to change more frequently when driving in dusty/dirty areas.
- **Steering/Front Suspension: Check for Wear**
- **Rear Suspension: Check for Wear**
- **Final Drive/Bevel Gear: Visual Inspection, Check for Leaks**
Only check the level if there is leakage.
(All-wheel Drive Models Only)
- **Driveshaft Joints: Check for Wear/Play**
- **Driveshafts: Check Rubber Boots**
- **Propeller Shaft, Pilot Bearing and Universal Joints: Check Wear**
(All-wheel Drive Models Only)
- **Brake Hoses and Lines: Check for Damage/ Leaks**

Every **60,000** Miles (60, 120)

- **Perform all items listed under “Every 20,000 Miles” section and include the items listed below.**
- **Spark Plugs: Replace**

At **80,000** Miles

- **Perform all items listed under “Every 40,000 Miles” section and include the items listed below.**
- **Accessory Drive Belt: Replace**

Every **150,000** Miles

- **Perform all items listed under “Every 10,000 Miles” section and include the items listed below.**
- **Accessory Drive Belt, Belt Tensioner and Idler Pulley: Replace**
Replace at 150,000 miles or 10 years, whichever comes first.
- **Water Pump Belt: Replace**
Replace at 150,000 miles or 10 years, whichever comes first.
- **Timing Belt, Tensioner and Idler Pulley: Replace**
Replace at 150,000 miles or 10 years, whichever comes first.

General

- **Software and Parts: Check/Replace**
Check and replace parts or software, as required by Volvo Car USA, LLC, that are covered under the terms of the Volvo New Car Warranty. For service intervals beyond 150,000 miles, consult your authorized Volvo dealer.



Note: Always utilize the VIDA system as the primary source of service interval information. Since VIDA can be updated, this document is for reference only.

Important: Only full synthetic oil meeting ACEA A5/B5 requirements should be used. Lower quality oils may not offer the same engine performance or engine protection.
